

Make a Cereal Boxer!

Step 1: Print this pattern. (Use the back of a used piece of paper if you can find one.)

Step 2: Rub the back side of the pattern with pencil to turn it into "carbon paper."

Step 3: Cut open a cereal box and use a piece of the cardboard that is big enough to fit the pattern.

Step 4: Place the pattern onto the cardboard and rub firmly over all of the lines. (Be careful to hold the pattern in place so it doesn't slip.)

Step 5: Cut out the two pattern pieces along the solid lines. Don't forget the slots. To cut the mouth, first fold the head along the dotted line.

Step 6: Use a hole puncher to cut the eyes.

Step 7: Bend the body into a "U" shape so the 4 legs touch the table, then slide the head onto the body using the slots.

Step 8: Customize the tail. You can make it pointy, frilly, or whatever you want.
